Supplies You Have Received

Supplies You'll Need

Tables – enough to fit your group Plastic Tablecloths, if needed Paper plates and paper towels Plastic or Paper Cups for Water Pens and Sharpies

* Feel free to supplement acrylic paint colors. We provide basic colors, but you can add any other colors you like. Note: gluing objects to hearts is not recommended - these always find a way to pop off. Same goes for sprinkled glitter!

COORDINATING ACTIVITIES



Set-Up

Best to do this before your guests arrive. Set up tables for painters in small groups and cover with plastic tablecloths. Use placemats included in your kit for each place setting. "Painters" will paint on their placemat and use a small paper plate to create their paint "palette." Small portions of paint work well.

Give everyone an unpainted heart and a message card. Place supply of brushes, pens and sharpies on each table. Cups with water and paper towels should be available on each guest's table.

Let the creativity flow!

Remind your painters this is "heartwork"

perfection is not necessary!

PAINTING TABLES

Usually in the front of the room, this table (or tables) includes unpainted hearts, greeting cards, paints and paper plates.

Note: remove unpainted hearts from their individual bubble bags before distributing to painters. Save small bubble bags for later when packaging hearts in gift bags.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR "PAINTERS"



- 1. Paint front and back of each heart allow 5 minutes to dry
- 2. Fill out Message Card while heart dries
- 3. Complete heart design on the front
- 4. When a heart is painted and message card complete, have painters write their first name on the back of their heart to help keep both together
- 5. Painters then return to the Painting Table to take another heart and card
- 6. Complete the above process

EASY INSTRUCTIONS ON FOLLOWING PAGE

Feel free to print copies of this to place on your painting tables. Note - placemats have these instructions as well.

DRYING TABLE (FOR LARGE OR SMALL EVENTS)

This table should be away from the unpainted supply tables and be an undisturbed place for hearts to completely dry. Keep painted hearts and cards together.

PACKAGING HEARTS IN GIFT BAGS*

Allow painted hearts to dry at least ½ hour. Because paint applications vary in thickness, be sure hearts are dry to the touch before taking next steps

Glazing

Mod Podge glaze was included in your kit. When hearts are dry, mod podge hearts on the front and sides. Mod Podge takes longer to dry than acrylic paint. If possible, allow at least one hour for drying – preferably overnight. Mod Podge goes on opaque and dries to a clear, glossy finish.

Ribbons

Pre-cut white ribbons were included in your kit. When Mod Podge glaze is dry, tie ribbons through the holes at the top of your painted hearts. You can replicate the bow from the sample heart that was included in your kit.

Gift Bags and Packaging*

Re-package painted and ribboned hearts in the small bubble bags each heart came with. Match and include corresponding message card. These should be placed in the white organza bags that came with your kit.

IMPORTANT*

* We often deliver to large facilities. Packaging is designed to make it easy to see what's in each bag.

Painted heart should show through the front of the organza bag and handwritten message should show through the back. Your sample shows this sequence.



WHEN YOUR HEARTS OF HOPE GIFTS ARE COMPLETE

Most groups already have a delivery group and location in mind and have painted Hearts of Hope for that intention. These deliveries are made by representatives of each painting group

RETURNING COMPLETED HEARTS OF HOPE TO US? SEE RETURN INSTRUCTIONS BELOW:

If you're unsure about breakage, use supplemental bubble wrap or wrapping paper. Hearts should be packed securely so that, when you shake the sealed box, nothing moves around inside – securely, but not too tightly.

As we receive your painted and packaged hearts and cards, we'll distribute to the area of your choice or to the area of greatest need as determined by requests for Hearts of Hope that we receive every day.
